



Autism Services Foundation offers an employment transition training camp for young adults on the autism spectrum.

Program Information is as follows:

Location: ASF Office 1866 El Centro, Napa, CA. 94558

Duration: 2 week sessions

Hours: Monday –Friday, 9am-1pm

Cost: \$450.00 per week

Students would benefit most from attending both of the weeks of the training camp.

The first week is a prerequisite for attending the second week of any session, but the weeks may be split.

The objective of the camp is to facilitate transitioning by providing training in job skills, including completing employment applications, writing a resume, preparing for an interview, and participating in a mock interview.

The training will go over all the tools and skills necessary to succeed in obtaining a job.

Autism Services Foundation is available for continued mentoring to the students of these sessions as they continue to look for work and become employed.

In collaboration with Work Force Napa and the Napa Chamber of Commerce, Autism Services Foundation helps to identify companies that would be interested in partnering with us and to provide follow up job search support for the students.

Autism Services Foundation Vocational Camp

Week 1 Sessions

Day 1

- Evaluation of individual strengths, weakness, and primary interest
- Matching jobs with skills and interests

Day 2

- Understanding job skills: schedules, punctuality, job responsibilities
- Identifying appropriate styles of dress for the work environment

Day 3

- Social understanding of job skills: customer service, phone skills, work place behavior
- How the chain of command of a company functions

Day 4

- On the job problem solving and communication skills
- Asking for help

Day 5

- Review of employment skills with each student
- Student assisted accommodation plan

Week 2 Session

Day 1

- Job search methods and techniques

Day 2

- How to fill out work documents: Employment applications, W2, I-9, writing a cover letter and resume.

Day 3

- Opportunities at Napa Valley College: vocational training, job search resources, educational choices

Day 4

- Interview practice and role playing

Day 5

- Implementing a plan for success
